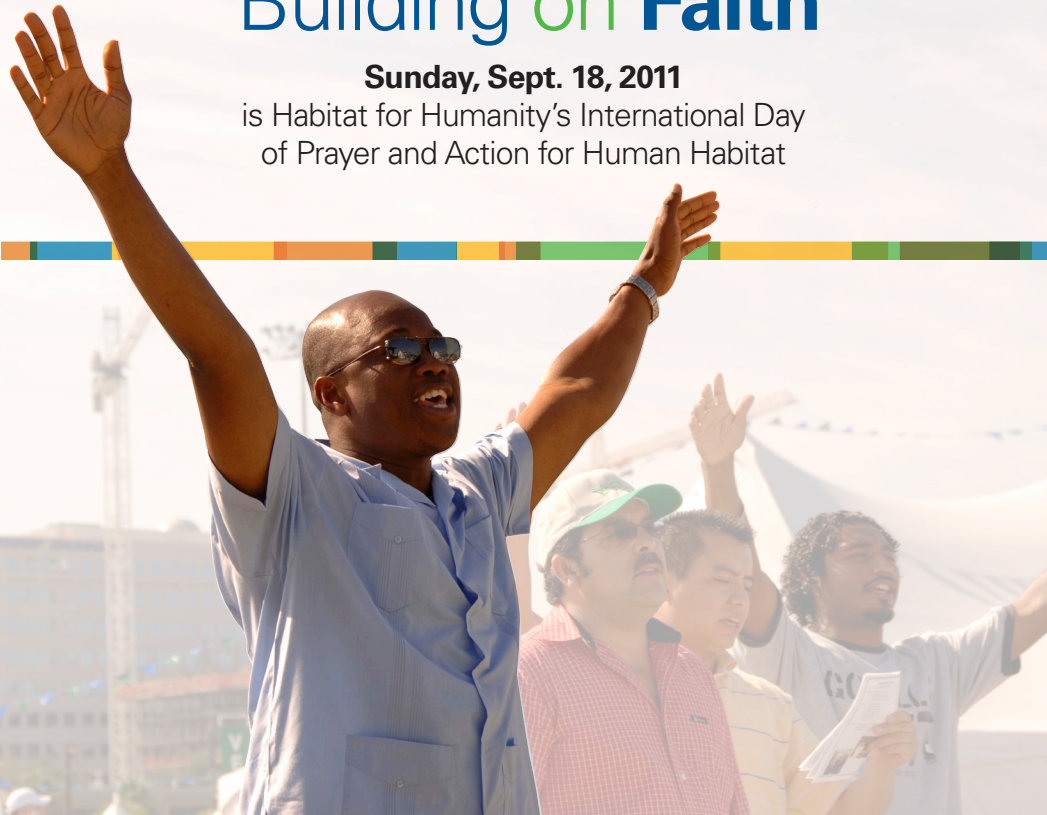

- **Volunteer**

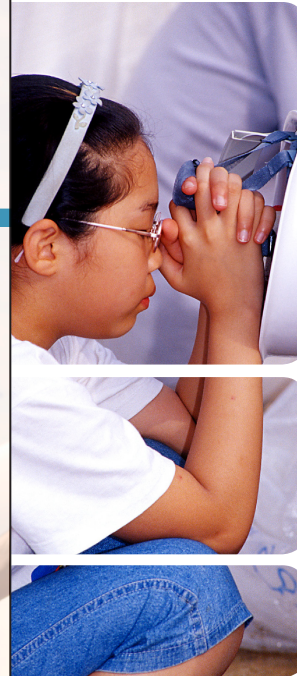
Volunteer at a local build site, prepare meals or travel abroad through our Global Village program.
