Dear Habitat Supporter,

Has your child started school or transferred to the next grade this year? Do you hope that your son or daughter will get a good education and achieve more in life than you or your parents did? You know, like many other parents do, that children with schooling do better in life. However, not all parents can focus on educating their children. Some struggle simply to get a roof over their heads and do not have a decent home to live in.

Zoran and Zaklina Damjanovski live in a small rented flat under the roof of one of the buildings in Veles, an industrial town in central Macedonia. The family cannot afford to move out from the place that it too small. They raise their two school aged boys, Mario and Petar, in this tiny flat hoping that one day they will have a safe and decent home of their own, where the boys will have enough room to study.

Hope is within reach for the Damjanovskis, and they will soon be able to improve their living conditions. Habitat for Humanity is building homes in Veles, with flats for 24 families available. Zoran, Zaklina and 23 other families have already contributed many hours of physical labor to build their new homes. Now only the final touches are missing, before they can realize their dream of a simple and decent home.

They do not ask you for a handout, just your hand-up to move forward. Even a small amount can help finish these homes faster. With your generous support the families can buy paint, nails, insulation, doors and windows for the new homes. You can help Zoran and Zaklina, as well as 23 other families, to move into their new homes before winter!
