Did you know that lack of clean water and proper sanitation claims more lives through disease than any war through guns?

At the same time, an ordinary person in the US or Western Europe taking a five-minute shower uses more water than a typical person in a developing country slum uses in a whole day.

In Tajikistan, a landlocked mountainous country in Central Asia, about 40 percent of the rural population lacks access to clean water. The Yuldoshevs, from Kumsangir, were one of them. Their only water source was a close-by irrigation canal. As a result, the children suffered from frequent stomach disorders or diarrhea.

Habitat's bio-sand water filter that purifies water and stops bacteria through layers of sand and gravel finally offered this family a solution and a glass of clean water.

A filter for one family costs around 140 dollars. If seven people donate 20 dollars, we can help one family. If 70 people donate the same amount, we can reach 10 families. Our goal is to support at least 300 families. Let's do it together this Easter!
