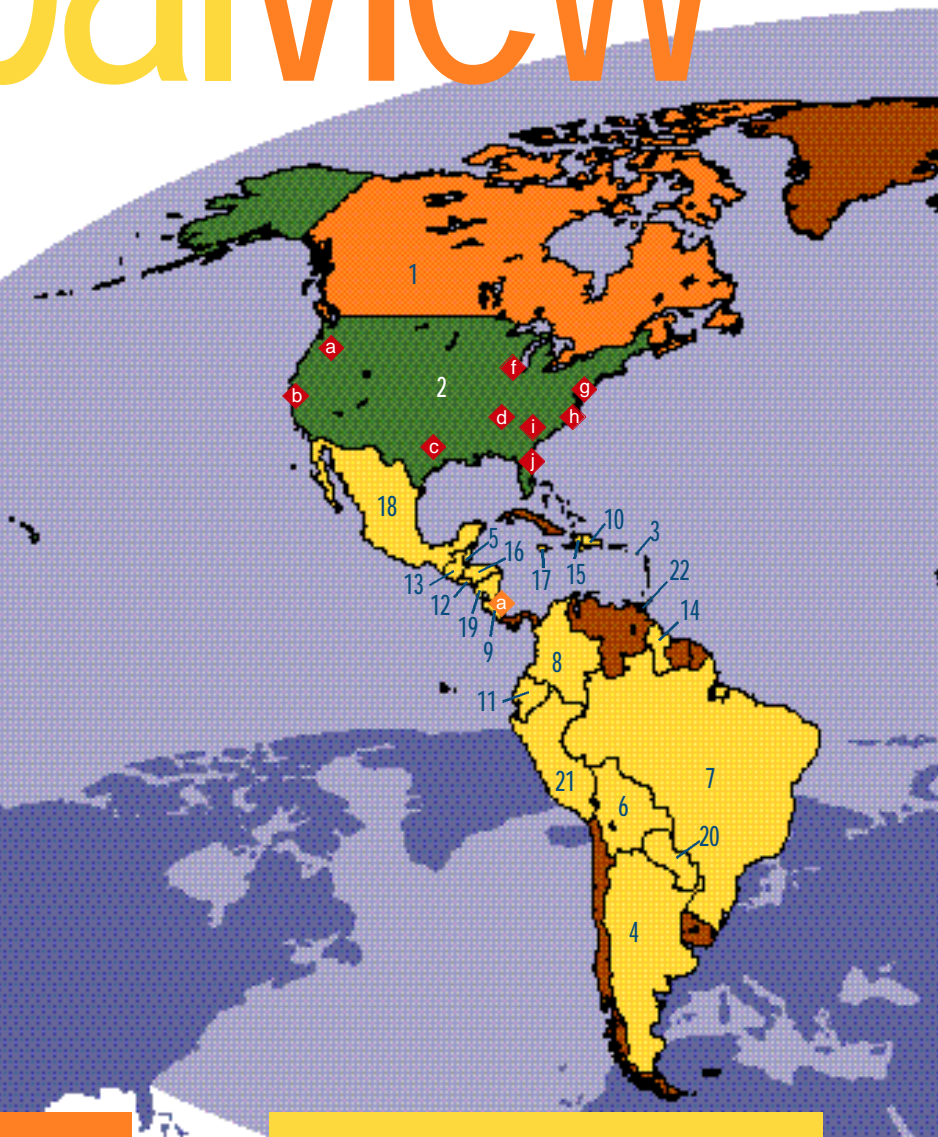

As part of its effort to expand homeownership opportunities around the world, Habitat for Humanity International has begun “rolling out” various offices, placing valuable support resources in strategic locations around the world.

This decentralization has resulted in nine Regional Support Centers across the United States and in Area Offices serving clusters of other countries around the world. HFHI has staffed these offices and supplied the areas with an important HFHI “field” presence.

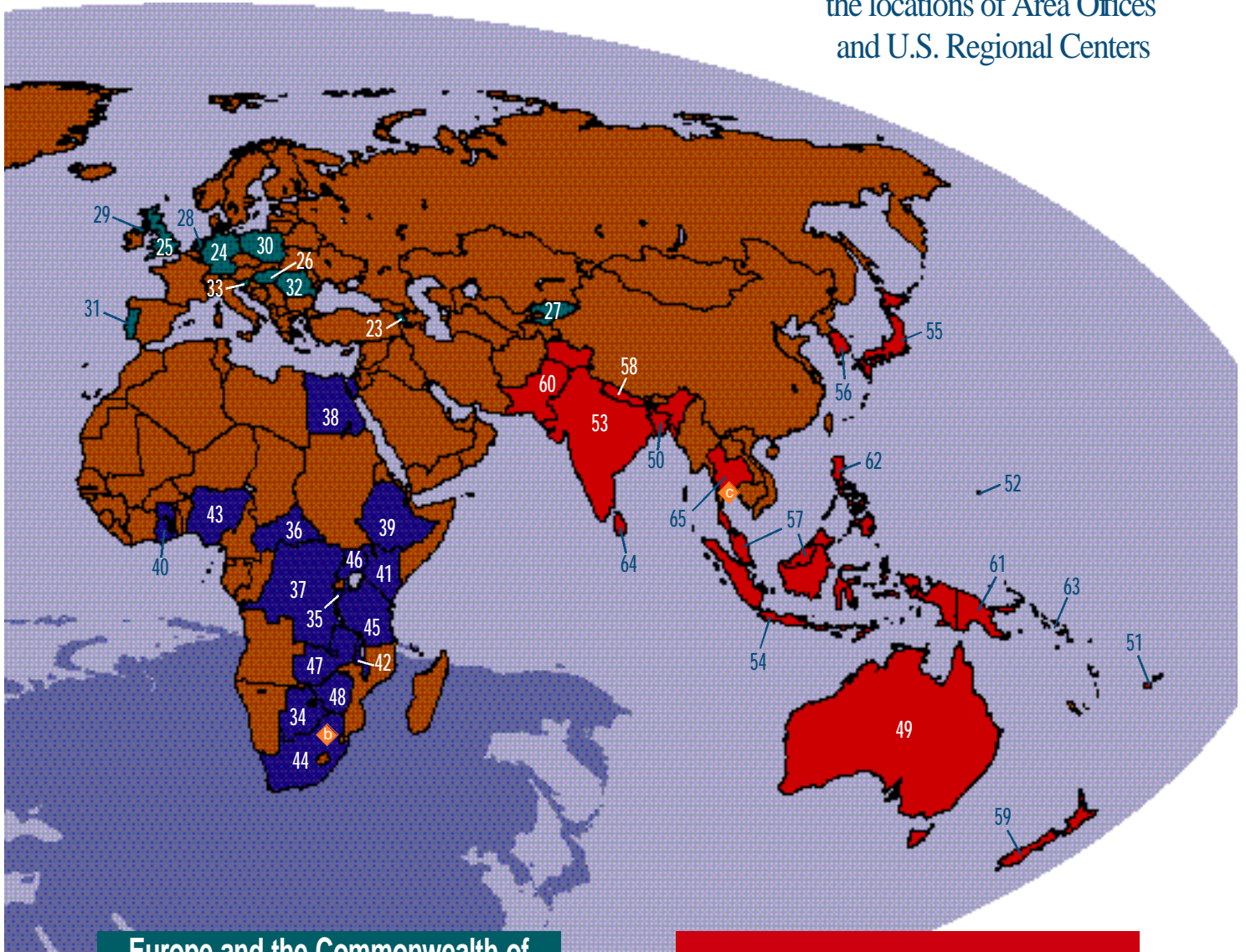
