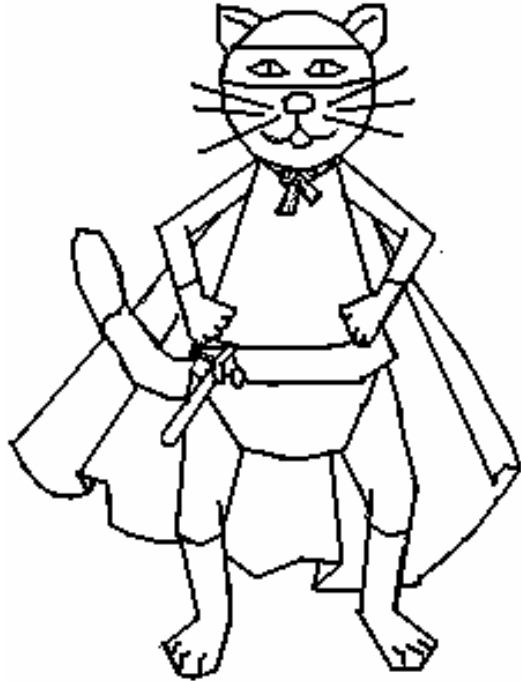


Habicat word game
