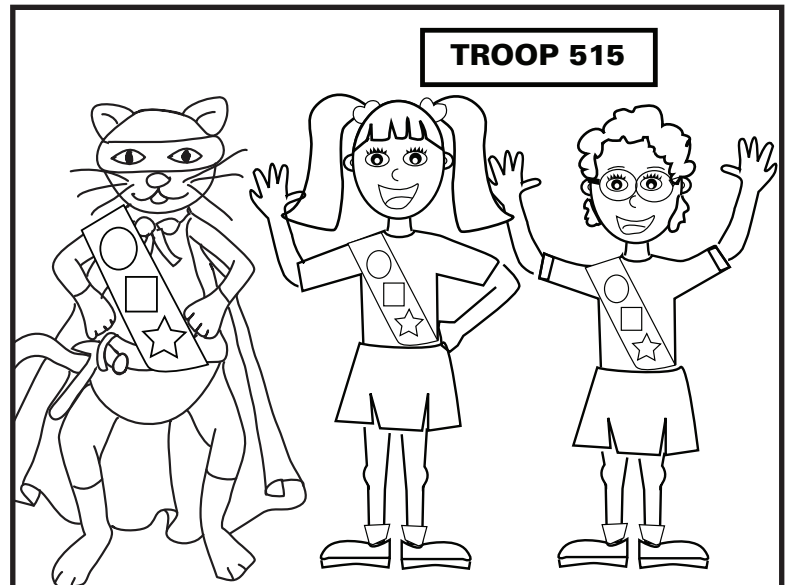
Susie wanted to participate in Act! Speak! Build! Week.

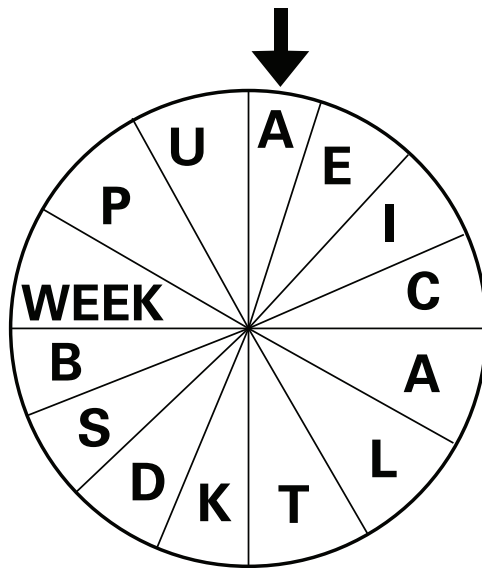
