

Habitat on the Hill 2024 | SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Habitat for Humanity is a vast network, comprising over 1,100 organizations operating in communities in every U.S. state.

When the network unites under a common goal, they are capable of enacting catalytic change. During the first three years of the Cost of Home campaign alone, Habitat affiliates successfully pursued **218 policy changes** that resulted in improved access to affordable and stable homes for **6.45 million people** and **\$17.95 billion** in government funding generated or allocated for home affordability and stability.

Habitat on the Hill, Habitat's annual legislative conference, brings nearly 400 Habitat staff members, board members, homeowners, resident leaders, volunteers and emerging leaders together to represent their communities; engage with each other; learn from experts in the housing field; and plan to advocate at the local, state and federal levels to enact policy solutions that advance home affordability. Attendees leave the three-day conference with practical tools and tactics to build influence locally, resulting in changes and positive impact that will be felt for years across hundreds of communities.

Attendees of Habitat on the Hill 2024 will gain valuable insight into the urgent need to the address housing supply shortage through policy change, how policy can be leveraged to advance racial equity, and will be guided by experts on effective advocacy strategies. The conference culminates in more than 300 impactful, in-person meetings with members of Congress and their staffs on Capitol Hill, where participants directly advocate for federal policy solutions that advance home affordability.

Last year, the conference sold out faster than ever before, illustrating the commitment of the Habitat network to pursue and implement policy solutions to advance home affordability across the United States. Emerging Leader Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded to more than 15 young leaders, ages 18-40, who are members of campus chapters or who are Habitat Young Professionals, based on their current engagement in Habitat's work. Scholarships include conference registration and hotel accommodations.

Habitat Homeowner Scholarships

Funding at this sponsorship level will provide more than 20 scholarships to Habitat homeowners, providing them with the opportunity to engage in learning and peer connection at Habitat on the Hill and share their personal stories of the value of homeownership with Habitat leaders and members of Congress.

Rural and Small Affiliate Scholarships

The financial and time costs associated with attending the conference may be prohibitive for some Habitat organizations that represent rural areas or have a limited or all-volunteer staff.
