Building together for a brighter future

During the communist times, the government provided loans for families to buy low-income housing in poor-quality prefabs. Once a market economy took hold, the responsibility for housing fell on the local authorities, who have no resources to deal with the problem. As a result, more and more homes need major repairs while many homeowners cannot afford even basic maintenance of their flats. Despite the new initiatives for making public space more accessible, most of the homes of people with disabilities do not meet their special needs. At the same time, over the past 20 years, rural areas experienced a major loss of employment, income and services. Habitat Bulgaria provides a wide range of services and products designed to meet particular housing needs. The organization employs construction products and services, including new builds; micro-finance products for home improvements, incremental repairs and energy saving improvements, advocacy efforts and participation in the policy-making in regard to housing.

Logistics

How to get there

Sofia airport to hotel in Sofia: 20-30 minutes. Hotel in Sofia to the worksite in Kostinbrod: 30 - 40 minutes.

Transportation

Both long-distance and daily transport to and from the hotel is typically in the form of a private minibus/bus with a hired driver.

Lodging


Hotels are simple and basic, and typically located near the project site. Each room sleeps 2-3 people and includes a private bathroom, although occasionally bathrooms are shared. All facilities are screened by HFH staff to ensure that everything is safe, clean and well-maintained.

Food and water

Breakfast and dinner: Served in the hotel or a local restaurant.

Lunch: Served at the worksite or in a local restaurant.

Water: Purified, bottled water is provided throughout the day.
