Habitat for Humanity Germany began operations in 1998. The national office is based in Cologne, with a team of about 20 staff members, one National Director and a five-person supervisory board.

Our work primarily focuses on raising funds for the international and local projects of Habitat for Humanity.

Habitat Germany's focus

Support and monitoring of international projects

For this purpose, Habitat Germany cooperates with private donors, companies and public donors, such as the BMZ, or Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development. Habitat Germany is also a member of Germany's biggest disaster response coalition Aktion Deutschland Hilft, or ADH.

Special emphasis is also placed on the initiative HoffnungsBAUer, or Hope Builders, in which corporations and companies from the construction and real estate industry can engage and get actively involved in corporate volunteering activities.

Habitat Germany also places focus on disaster areas worldwide such as in Ukraine, Turkey, Germany's Ahr valley as well as sub-Saharan Africa and particularly disadvantaged regions in Asia and Eastern Europe.

In addition to a wide range of disaster relief measures and traditional house building, efforts are made to support projects in which several groups of people can be reached in a measurable and sustainable way, e.g. water, sanitation and hygiene, market development and vocational training/livelihoods.

Implementation of local projects with focus on housing

Currently we enable refugees to have adequate homes in the region of Cologne and provide disaster relief assistance in the town of Dernau, near Bonn.
