

- Results and learnings from the **ground-breaking "Building Assets, Unlocking Access" project**.

[Habitat for Humanity](#), in partnership with the [Mastercard Foundation](#), has been implementing the "[Building Assets, Unlocking Access](#)" project and providing technical assistance to financial institutions in Kenya and Uganda to develop housing microfinance products. To date, the products have reached over 42,000 households and mobilized over US\$ 33 million in capital to benefit over 210,000 individuals.
